*Notes:* Countries within each income category have been ordered by HDI value. The HDI ranges between 0 (minimum) to 1 (maximum). Higher values indicate high human development. The GDI ranges between 0 (minimum) to 1 (maximum). Higher values indicate greater gender equality. The GEM ranges between 0 (minimum) and 1 (maximum). Higher values indicate greater gender equality. The GGI varies between 0 to 1. Higher values indicate greater gender equality.

HDI, GDI and GEM values are from the global indices (UNDP 2009). While many countries have national human development reports (NHDRs), only global indices have been presented in the interest of cross-country comparability.
